In his case his eyes process information faster, his sense of touch, smell and taste also followed suit. For the rest of their lives, any child whose senses are altered becomes very special. It’s almost seems like a sixth sense takes over. He knows speaking through experience.”

With loving guidance from his grandfather Bump, who literally took Richard by the hand. Explained and showed him how to develop film and print pictures. Also, studying every magazine and book having to do with photography helped with composition, technique and subject matter.

Growing up with a hearing problem isolated and gave the artist a different interpretation of this world. The only thing he could hear were products that had a volume control stereo, TV. The artist learned early in life that people’s actions speak louder than their words.

In the artists life everything seems to come in twos. Not only does the award winning artist have a much anticipated art exhibit. He also is exhibiting this show in his own private art gallery named Water Song.

Water Song Studio and Gallery sits high above the Alplaus Creek inside a hundred year old two story barn. The property is surrounded by waterfalls, one of which is thirty feet high. A landscape photographer’s paradise!
